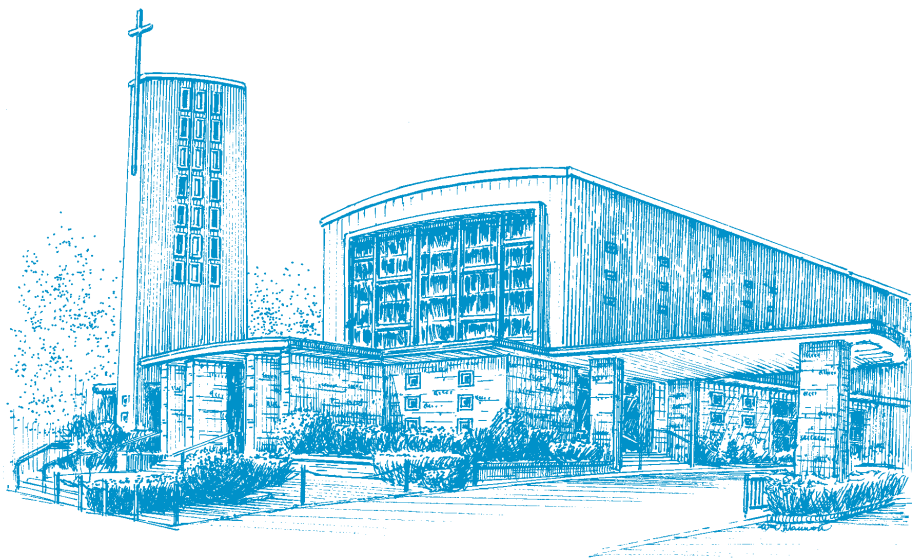

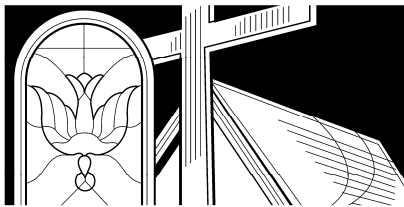

Spiritual Reflection

“Where are you?” “Come home now!” “We’re leaving.” “It’s time to go to bed.” It’s not rare at all for us to be called. Our parents call us when they want to make sure we’re safe. Sometimes we’re called because someone needs our help. The phone is used for calling, too, and often the caller wants to make sure we are all right.

Sometimes, we don’t listen. There are times, when, as children, we really don’t want to go to bed. Not many of us enjoy getting involved in something that looks like work. There are times when we don’t really want to answer the call. Our phones are sometimes equipped with Caller ID, so we can decide whose call we are going to take.

God calls us many times each day. Sometimes we listen. Other times we don’t. There are plenty of opportunities each day for us to get involved in helping others. Sometimes, though, we’re too busy, in a hurry or don’t want to get involved. We can begin formulating “excuses” as soon as we’re asked to help. Sometimes, when the call is a little more general, we decide that someone else could do a better job. Then we wait for them to volunteer.

In today’s First Reading, the Lord says to Samuel that when he is called he should say, “Speak, Lord, your servant is listening.” Our Psalm response says, “Here I am, Lord, I come to do your will.” We might expect those who are older to say these kinds of things. After all, they have more time. They’re more mature and talented. But when God’s call comes, God is calling “us,” whether we are seven years old or ninety-seven!

In our Gospel, we hear of Simon and Andrew. They first heard the Lord’s call through John, and now are followers of Jesus. We find Jesus giving Simon the name “Cephas” which is rendered “Peter.” We know of Peter’s weaknesses, even to the point of denying Jesus three times. Jesus was able to see through that weakness at the potential Peter had. My guess is that Peter was not terribly judgmental, since he couldn’t deny his own weaknesses.

Jesus could have chosen anyone to follow him, but he chose mostly fishermen and those who weren’t so important in the way the world judged importance. Those people were most often “too busy” or “too important” to stop and listen to somebody else. God does not judge as we judge; that’s for sure. We’ll be called this week! Perhaps we’ll be given a chance to shovel snow, listen to someone’s problem, play with a child who is sometimes left out, or give of our time, talent or treasure to someone who is in need. Let’s make a real effort not to devise excuses as soon as we hear the call, but consider more carefully whether God would like us to respond.

This week we can notice the needs of others, and help out. This week we can seek God’s will and pray for the courage to carry it out. Opportunities will present themselves. Let’s be ready. Have a good week!

Pastor’s Notes**BÓG NAS WZYWA...**

“Mów Panie, bo Twój sługa słucha...”
Nasza modlitwa, to często lawina słów rzucanych w stronę nieba. Niejednemu z nas wydaje się może, że im więcej słów powie, tym lepiej się modli. Jeśli w ten sposób będziemy patrzeć na naszą modlitwę, to będzie to jedynie monolog, niegodny ani Boga ani człowieka.

Niegodny Boga, ponieważ On doskonale wie, czego nam potrzeba. Wielomówność wobec Boga świadczy o zapomnieniu, kim On jest. Z drugiej strony zarzucanie Boga słowami jest niegodne człowieka, który powinien brać pełną odpowiedzialność za każde swoje słowo. Każdy z nas powinien być odpowiedzialny za swoje słowo, za to, co mówi.

Panu Bogu nie chodzi o nasze słowa wypowiedzane wargami, ale chodzi o to, co kryje i czuje nasze serce, z którego te słowa pochodzą. Każda bowiem modlitwa—to jakby mowa naszego serca. Serce zaś nigdy nie wypowiada zbędnych słów. Ono waży bardzo dokładnie każde słowo i dlatego potrafi w jednym zdaniu powiedzieć swoim uczniom: „A gdy się modlicie, nie bądźcie gadatliwi jak poganie, którzy sądzą, że dla swej wielomówności będą wysłuchani.” Natomiast Żydom wyrzucał Jezus mówiąc: „Ten lud czci Mnie wargami, ale serce jego dalekie jest ode mnie.”

Mogę więc sobie postawić pytanie: Kiedy po raz ostatni rozmawiałem z Bogiem w swoim sercu? Może jedni odpowiedzą sobie, że przed dwoma minutami, słuchając słów Ewangelii; inni, że tuż po przebudzeniu; a jeszcze inni będą długo szukać w swoich dniach i tygodniach, a może i latach takiej chwili, kiedy tak naprawdę sercem rozmawiali z Bogiem.

Drugi wreszcie problem, który wcale nie jest nam obcy podczas naszych modlitw—to wielomówność! Nasze modlitwy są często monologami, w których zasypujemy Boga słowami i odchodzimy, nie interesując się wcale tym, co On ma do powiedzenia. Najczęściej nie zamierzamy słuchać tego, co nam Bóg ma do powiedzenia. Tymczasem modlitwa to spotkanie z Bogiem, o którym wiem, że mnie kocha i ma mi tysiąc razy więcej do powiedzenia, niż ja Jemu mówię! Bardzo jasno tę myśl przedstawia nam Pismo Święte na przykładzie młodego Samuela: „Mów, Panie, bo sługa Twój słucha.” Samuel modlił się od dawna mówiąc pacierze, jakich nauczyła go jego matka, jakich nauczył się przebywając w świątyni, ale nowy etap życia religijnego rozpoczął się w chwili, gdy powiedział Bogu: „Mów, Panie...” Dopiera taka modlitwa jest prawdziwą modlitwą wypływającą z serca człowieka i jest ona najbardziej prawdziwą i rzeczywistą modlitwą. My natomiast zbyt często na modlitwie zamykamy nasze serce przed Bogiem i nie pozwalamy, by Boże Słowo padła na glebę naszego serca. Tutaj jest nasz największy błąd! Słuchać słowa Bożego, to znaczy przyjąć je sercem i realizować to, czego domaga się od nas Pan Bóg.

A Tragic Commemoration

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court, in the Roe vs. Wade decision, made its worst mistake in history. By declaring that children in the womb are not "persons," it opened the door to tens of millions of abortions.

According to the Alan Guttmacher Institute (the research arm of Planned Parenthood, which is the single largest source of abortions in America), in 2005, 1.21 million abortions took place in the United States. Some 42,350 of these occurred on women who were 16 to 20 weeks pregnant; over 13,310 occurred on women who were 21 weeks or more into their pregnancy. In light of CDC government data, one can conclude that over 64,000 abortions in a year are performed on women who had *three or more previous abortions*. From 1973 to 2005, more than 45 million legal abortions occurred in our country.

Indeed, as we mark another Roe vs. Wade commemoration, it is time for all of us to get involved in efforts to end abortion. Visit www.priestsforlife.org/action to learn what you can do.
